

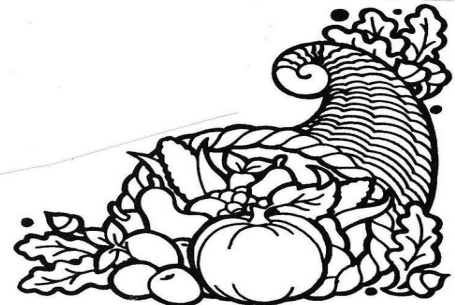
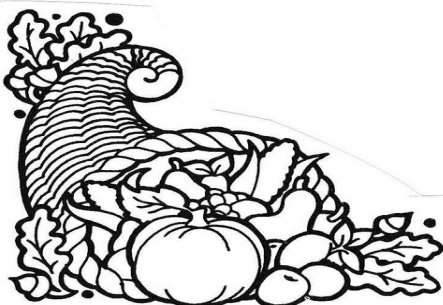
October Verde Shores News
